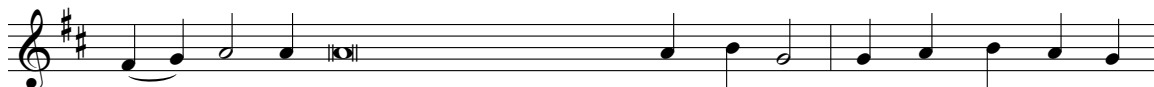




**Prokeimenon** (Psalm 28:11,1,2):
