






Glo-ry to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Ho-ly Spir - it, now and ev - er and for-ev - er. A - - - men.

**Kontakion of the Resurrection - Tone 6**




Christ our God, the Life - giv - er, with his life - giving hand raised the dead



from the val - ley of death, grant-ing res - ur - rec - tion to all of us. He is the Sav - ior of All, the Resurrection, the Life, and the God of All.


**Prokeimenon (Psalm 27:9,1):**
