



**Troparion of the Resurrection - Tone 1**




The stone was sealed by the Jews, soldiers guard - ed your most pure



 O Christ, it is you who give res - ur - rec - tion to all.


**Prokeimenon - Tone 1 (Psalm 32:22,1):**
