

THIRD SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST


The Synaxis of the Twelve Apostles. Although each of the Twelve Apostles has his own feast day during the year, the Church has set aside this day for a general feast of all of them together.

Troparion of the Resurrection - Tone 2
