THE RITE FOR THE BLESSING OF THE HOME

STAND

The members of the household who desired to have their home blessed during the Feast of the Theophany gather together around a table with a lighted candle, holy water, and a cross. Other items to be blessed may also be placed on the table.

Celebrant: Blessed is our God, always, now and ever and forever.

Lord, have mer - cy.




