




## Divine Liturgy Propers, January 27, 2012 SUNDAY OF THE PRODIGAL SON




## **Troparion of the Resurrections -** *Tone 2*




## Troparion of the Translation of the Relics of St. John Chrysostom - $\mathit{Tone}\ 8$








## Kontakion of the Prodigal Son - Tone 3



**Prokeimenon of the Resurrection -** *Tone 2* (Psalm 117:14,18):




*Verse:* The Lord punished me severely but did not hand me over to Death.
