Twelfth Sunday after Pentecost



Lamplighting Psalms in the Tone of the Week (Tone 3, p. 48), stichera 10-4.


Cantor: (Tone 8) Because with the Lord there is mercy and fullness of redemption,


What shall we call you now, O Pi - men? A mod - el for monks, a work-er

(on 2) acclaim him all you peoples!




How can we de-scribe you now, O Pi - men? A cit - izen of the desert,
