


O merciful One, bless the course of this year, and in your bound-less

Prokeimenon of the New Year - Tone 3 (Psalm 146: 5, 1):




Great is our Lord and great is his pow - er. His un - der-stand-ing

Alleluia of the Resurrection - Tone 3 (Psalm 30: 2,3):


