


**Divine Liturgy Propers, October 6, 2019**  
**SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST**



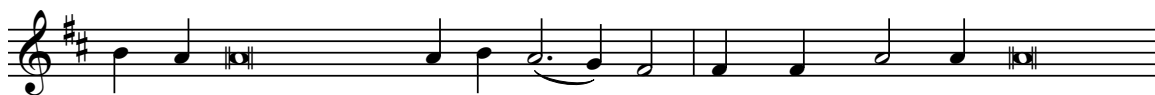

**Prokeimenon of the Resurrection - Tone 8 (Psalm 75:12,2):**





**Alleluia of the Resurrection - Tone 8 (Psalm 94:1,2):**




