
Propers for the Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts Friday in the Fifth Week of the Great Fast March 24, 2023

THE ANNUNCIATION OF THE MOTHER OF GOD AND EVER-VIRGIN MARY when, in the city of Nazareth, the angel of the Lord announced to Mary, "Behold, you will conceive and bear a son, and he will be called the Son of the Most High." Mary said: "Behold the handmaid of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word." And thus the fullness of time was accomplished, and he who before time was the only-begotten Son of God was made flesh for our sake and for our salvation, by the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary and became human.



Sticheron of Friday in the Fifth Week of the Great Fast - Tone 6 samohlasen











Readings for the Annunciation:

Genesis 28: 10-17


Exodus 3: 1-8

Proverbs 8: 22-31

The service continues with the Solemn Evening Psalm on p. 25.

If desired, Litija may be sung after the Ambon prayer. Then the celebrant sings the Troparion of the Annunciation once, censing the bread, wheat, wine, and oil. The people sing the Annunciation Troparion twice (incensing), the priest then blesses the litija, and all sing "Blessed be the name..." in the Lenten tone, and the Dismissal. The bread will be distributed at Matins.

If bread is not blessed, the troparion of the Annunciation may be sung after the dismissal.
