


**Divine Liturgy, October 6, 2024**  
**TWENTIETH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST**



**Troparion of the Resurrection - Tone 3**




Let the heav - ens re - joice, let the earth be glad; for the Lord

**Troparion of the holy apostle Thomas - Tone 2**




You were both a disciple of Christ and a member of the ap - os - tol - ic col - lege.
